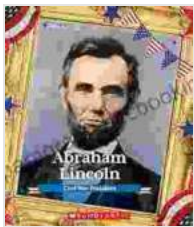

## Early Life and Education



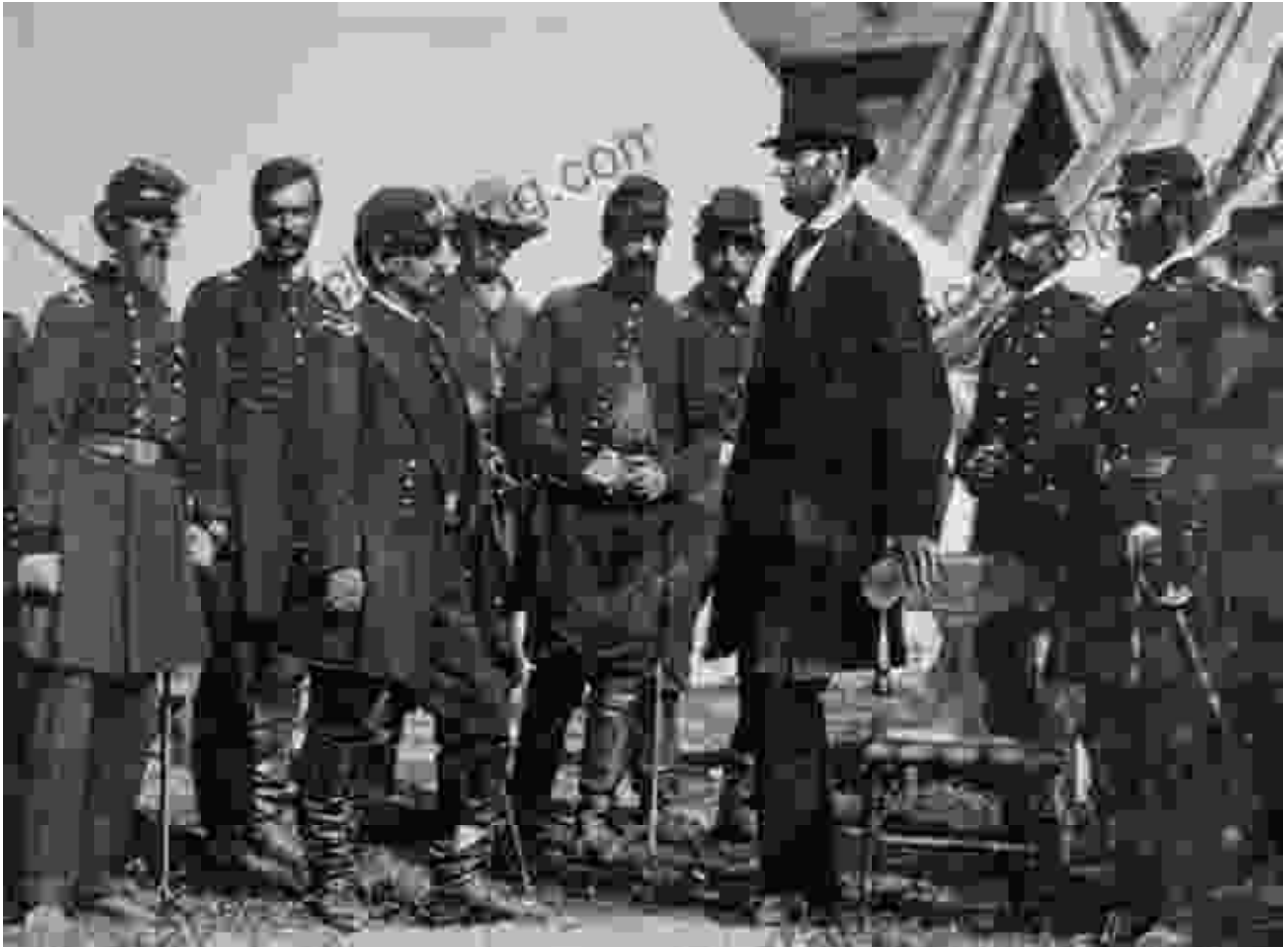

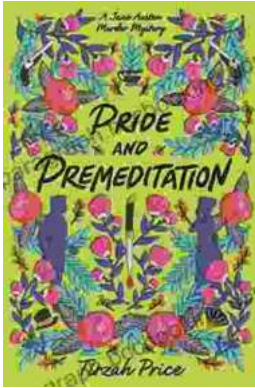

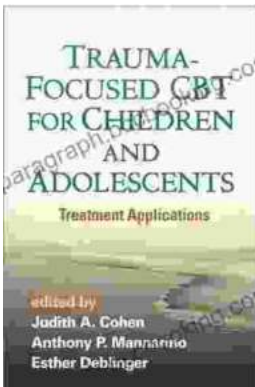
