- 2. Score the plasticard along the edges where you want to bend it. This will help to prevent the plasticard from cracking when you bend it.
- 3. Bend the plasticard to the desired shape. I bent the plasticard in a "U" shape to fit over the front of the Rhino.
- 4. Apply super glue to the edges of the plasticard and attach it to the Rhino. Make sure to press firmly and hold the plasticard in place until the glue dries.
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 for any other areas of the Rhino that you want to add extra armour to.




